THE MINISTRY OF THE APOSTLE

The word "apostle" means **one who is sent forth with a special commission**. Although the twelve apostles are unique in that they are witnesses of the Resurrection, the New Testament mentions 23 apostles in all.

Jesus was the **great Apostle**, *Heb 3:1,2*, **the chief foundation stone**, *Eph 2:20*, **the head of the Church**, *Eph 1:22*.

Apostles, with prophets, are the **foundation** ministries of the Church, *Eph 2:20*.

While the apostle may reside in one local Church for a great length of time, his ministry is to the Body of Christ at large.

THE MINISTRY OF THE PROPHET

This ministry is referred to as that of a “seer” in the Old Testament, *1Sam 9:9,10*. The word “prophet” means one who speaks forth and describes another “foundational ministry” in the Church, *Eph 2:20*.

An important distinction: The “gift of prophecy” of *1Cor 12:10* ought not to be confused with the ministry of the prophet. All may prophesy, *1Cor 14:31*, but not all are prophets, *1Cor 12:29*.

The person operating a **gift of prophecy** receives the gift when needed; the **prophet** has received an enduring commission.

Personal directive prophecy should **confirm** the convictions of the person being spoken to rather than be “news”. If it is “news”, then the person being spoken to, needs to seek the Lord to hear from God themselves, as well.

THE MINISTRY OF THE PASTOR

The word for “pastor,” “poimen,” is found in the New Testament 16 times. Only once is it translated “pastor”, *Eph 4:11*, elsewhere it is translated “shepherd” as in *Heb 13:20*. In the New Testament, there is
