4. Young children love having Bible stories read to them after the evening meal. You can buy books of Bible stories with exciting pictures. This is a good time to sing scripture verses that have been set to music and it is a painless way to learn God's Word.
5. As the family grows it is a great blessing to read missionary adventure stories. These inspire us to serve God and learn how other men and women have discovered God's power, protection and provision

How to Plan this Special Time with God

1. Pick a time and place where you can spend this time with God without being interrupted. Early mornings are best! *Ps 63:1*
2. Begin your time with praise and worship. Praise God and thank Him for who He is to you, what He has done for you and others etc. Praying through Psalms 145-150 is a big help to many people. There are many other Psalms of praise too.
3. Have a time for confession of any conscious sins. Ask God for His forgiveness according to *1Jn 1:7,9*.
4. Pray for yourself, family, church, friends, unsaved people, city leaders and government, as you are led by the Holy Spirit.
5. Pick a short passage from the Bible and read through it a few times, slowly and thoughtfully. Start with the Gospels of the New Testament. As you read ask the Lord to teach you some lessons from the passage, *Ps 119:18*. Think about ways you can apply the lessons in your own life, situation and circumstances. Finish with a prayer.
6. Keep a notebook to write down what the Lord says to you each day, *Is 50:4; Jer 31:21*.

Helps with the Daily Bible Reading and Prayer Time

1. There are many books published of daily Bible readings, such as “The Word for Today”, “Daily Light”, “Table in the Wilderness”, “Every Day with Jesus”, etc. and these can be a great encouragement.
